Demonstrated involvement and participation in **Community Service**

- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, Completed minimum of 12 quarter units, Must be enrolled in the 2023-2024 school year
- MUST complete the Supplemental questions provided in the application
- Must provide evidence of community service and leadership, through volunteer (non-paid) activities either on-campus or in the broader, local APIDA community within the past 2 years
- Minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, Completed minimum of 12 quarter units, Must be enrolled in the 2023-2024 school year
- MUST complete the Supplemental questions provided in the application
- Must demonstrate financial need.
- Demonstrated involvement and participation can be either:
 - (1) volunteered or participated in an Asian Pacific Islander Desi American (APIDA) on-campus club or community activity within the last 2 years in any capacity. OR
 - **(2)** completion of a qualifying *Asian American Studies course:
 - ASAM (Asian American and Asian Studies) 1, 10, 11, 12, 13, 20, 21, 22, 30, 31, or 32; ELIT (English Literature) 24; NAIS (Native American and Indigenous Studies) 31; WMST (Woman Studies) 22

Demonstrate leadership and a strong commitment to Activism, Community
Organizing

- Minimum 2.7 cumulative GPA, Completed minimum of 12 quarter units, Must be enrolled in the 2023-2024 school year
- MUST complete the Supplemental provided questions in the application
- Must provide evidence of community service and leadership, through volunteer activities either on-campus or in the broader APIDA (Asian Pacific Islander Desi American) community in the past two years
