WHO WE ARE

ELIGIBILITY

- Enrolled in 12+ units (or less if approved by DSS or EOPS Counselor)
- Be a California Resident, AB540, or Daca Student
- Completed less than 105 degree-applicable units & not have earned a Bachelor's Degree
- Be academically AND financially disadvantaged as determined by CA State EOPS guidelines (See below for more details)

ACADEMIC DISADVANTAGE CRITERIA

At least 1 or more of the following must apply to you:

- 1st-Generation college student
- English is NOT your parents' native/first language
- Previously enrolled in remedial (basic education) courses in High School and/or College

FINANCIAL DISADVANTAGE CRITERIA

At least 1 or more of the following must apply to you:

- Be eligible for the California Promise Grant Program (CCPG Part A or B)
- Meet the CCPG Part B 2023-2024 Income Standards (Based on 2021 IRS Tax/Household Information)
