Hyon Chu Yi-Baker is connecting student groups and clubs with Village Centers to stimulate community, support retention, and build success.






The Village Centers: Ribbon Cutting, February 14, 2023

Each Village is a **supportive community** of students, faculty and staff members who share interests and goals, and as you likely recall, the Villages Live Centers opened on February 14, 2023






