#### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH is flat at 262,818.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount is flat at 21,711.
- Resident WSCH is down 1% at 226,491.
- Non-resident WSCH is up 11% at 36,327.

#### International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status increased 10% from 1,671 to 1,835.
- Females comprise 44% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, South Korea and Indonesia.

#### Online Education

- Total online education estimated WSCH is up 18% at 22,396.
- Online education headcount is up 11% from 3,250 to 3,592.
- Online education course enrollment is up 16% from 4,495 to 5,220.
