### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident enrollment decreased 6% from 55,729 to 52,434.
- Total resident and non-resident FTES decreased 6% from 5,841 to 5,518.
- Resident FTES is down 7% from 4,988 to 4,651, and non-resident FTES up 2% from 853 to 867.

### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment Categories

- Within the resident category, total enrollment of AB540 students decreased 7% from 2,184 to 2,022 while FTES decreased 8% from 226 to 209.
- Within the non-resident category, enrollment of students from another country (with or without an educational visa) decreased 2% from 6,897 to 6,792 while FTES decreased 1% from 713 to 707.

### International Students

- International students with F1 or FZ visa status headcount is at 1,869, down from 1,905 last fall, a 2% change from fall to fall.
- Females comprise 37% of the international students with F1 or FZ visa status.
- Top countries of origin for F1 or FZ international students includes: China, Vietnam, South Korea, Japan, Taiwan, and Indonesia.

- Total online education estimated FTES is up 17% from 633 to 741.
- Online education course enrollment is up 18% from 6,468 to 7,617.

### Ethnicity

- Latino/a headcount decreased 4% from 5,992 to 5,732 and FTES decreased 4% from 1,525 to 1,464.
- African American headcount decreased 5% from 927 to 885 and FTES decreased 5% from 249 to 237.
- Filipino headcount decreased 7% from 1,587 to 1,475 while FTES decreased 10% from 435 to 391.

### Student Type

- First-time student headcount decreased 8% from 3,257 to 2,994 and FTES decreased 4% from 998 to 954.
- First-time transfer student headcount decreased 8% from 2,954 to 2,731 while FTES decreased 12% from 672 to 592.
- Continuing student headcount decreased 4% from 12,286 to 11,763 and FTES decreased 6% from 3,547 to 3,335.
- Returning student headcount decreased 3% from 3,050 to 2,945 and FTES decreased 1% from 585 to 578.
- High school student enrollment increased 53% from 234 to 359 and FTES increased 51% from 39 to 59.

- Headcount from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 7% from 11,281 to 10,501.
- Headcount from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell decreased 8% from 4,763 to 4,387.

**Zip Code Groupings – Percentage of Total Enrolled**

- As a percentage of total headcount, students from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga increased 1% at 21% of total headcount enrollment.
- Headcount from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 1% at 51% of total headcount.
- Headcount from San Jose Other, Santa Clara, Morgan Hill, Gilroy, and Campbell decreased 1 percentage point at 21% of total enrollment.

**Zip Code Groupings – By Ethnicity**

- African American headcount from the Cupertino area increased 11% while African American headcount decreased by 1% in the San Jose East of 880 area and by 15% in the San Jose Other area.

- Filipino headcount increased 2% in the Cupertino area, decreased 9% in the San Jose East of 880 area and decreased 4% in the San Jose Other area.
- Latino/a headcount decreased 2% in the Cupertino area, 4% in the San Jose East of 880 areas, and 7% in the San Jose Other area.
